## Annual report for 2020 of Ellen Margrethe Krabbe

The members of the board of HumanCare Russia want to continue our social humanitarian work to help the families of Fr. Pavel's congregation in need. We continue to work to spread awareness of HCR and to increase the number of members. We have held 5 board meetings, in addition several telephone meetings. We have held 3 events where we have informed about the association's history and humanitarian work. It was March 6 in Emdrup Church, August 12 in Hundige Church, (Zealand) and September 12 in Skjern (Jutland) at an annual meeting with SMF (health staff mission community) and LMF (Teachers' Mission Association). In this connection, we have sent a Fund application to SMF. Unfortunately we did not receive anything.

There have been several renewals and updates on our website, including the English version. Newsletters have been sent out to members and friends of HCR. We have sent greetings on HCR's FB page, where we have received 150 likes. In 2020, we had 29 paying members.

Due to the year with Corona, we have only had 2 bazaars: 4 October "Karlslunde Strandkirke" and 22 November in "Bethlemskirken". We got a nice result along with the money that was collected in the churches. Elisabeth Louise had published a fine catalog, and thus we sold something more.


We have had regular contact per. mail with our coordinator in Moscow, Irina Smirnova, about the situation in Moscow. This year with Corona, we have been extra concerned about our friends in Moscow. That is the reason we have been happy with Irina's information. She wrote that Father Pavel and several others in the congregation have been quarantined several times both at home and outside the city. At the same time, we have been told which families needed help. We have sent donations to them and received receipts directly from the families, so that the help has reached exactly those who needed it. It had been our intention to visit the congregation, but it is postponed.

We want to thank everyone who helped with HCR's events. Thank you for your prayers and for your support and backing. I will end my account with a quote from Mother Teresa:

"We can not do great things, but we can do small things with great love."
