

Hard times in Moscow

It has been a very difficult summer for our community. Father Pavel helped to make repairs in the apartment of one very sick woman. He practically did not have any assistants, because in the summer everyone goes on vacation or to summer cottages. He had to use his own money to buy materials for repairs, because his parishioner does not have any financial resources. His only assistant fell seriously ill very quickly and was hospitalized. Another old parishioner of ours, Irina Kolos, suffered a heavy loss. Her daughter Lyuba was ill for a very long time and was very seriously ill when they went to the doctors, she was diagnosed with cancer, she was operated on, and after a very difficult week in intensive care, Lyuba died. Another our good friend is also seriously ill with cancer. Today, the husband of Larisa M. ended up in the hospital with a heart attack. Father Pavel talks a lot with them, trying to support them morally and prayerfully. The whole current situation has a very heavy effect on the mood and condition of people.

Father Pavel is on vacation in September. One of the congregation's parishioners, Ekatarina, accompanied him on his vacation. And Irina wrote: "And I am very happy that Father Pavel is now resting during his summer vacation."

Ukrainian refugees in Moscow

Irina Wrote: "I wanted to share some good news with you, but there aren't many. Many of our parishioners are trying to help Ukrainians who ended up in Russia. We collect things because they have absolutely nothing. Often we find housing for them, we place them in our apartments, because among them there are small children and elderly people. Now is a very special time."

Irina wrote on Connie Meyer's birthday, November 18th,

remembering last year when we were able to hold a memorial day

for Connie almost on her birthday. Irina hoped that a time would soon come when it would be possible to travel again so that we could visit each other.

She wrote: "Your support and your prayers are very important to us. It is very valuable to know that there are people in the world who continue to be warm to our community and have good feelings for our parishioners when the whole world has gone crazy. Therefore, I think I will express the

general feelings of great and warmest gratitude to your foundation. With warmest wishes, Irina"
